The most comprehensive reference work on Catholic spirituality. The *Dictionnaire* contains long, signed articles covering concepts of spiritual theology explaining their origin and development through the centuries with frequent references to sources.

Articles on particular topics (e.g. community, love, mortification) and on particular schools (e.g. Augustinian, Carmelite, Salesian). This work does not include biographical articles. Since this is a dictionary of contemporary Catholic spirituality, historical topics are treated only insofar as they relate to Catholic spirituality since Vatican II.

New Catholic Encyclopedia. Detroit: Thompson/Gale, 2003. 15 volumes
Reference BX 841 N44 2003

The major English-language encyclopedia on Catholic topics. It contains some 17,000 articles, each with a bibliography. -. Use this work for an overview of a subject and to see how it can be divided into narrower topics for research. For historical articles, the student should also refer to *The Catholic Encyclopedia* (Reference BX 841 C 19). Or *The New Catholic Encyclopedia* (Reference BX 841 .N44 1967)

The dictionary is an alphabetically arranged source, of Church Fathers, pre-Reformation spiritual masters, spiritual traditions and terms.

An ecumenical work dealing with topics and persons from all schools of spirituality, Christian and non-Christian. All major Catholic schools of spirituality are covered.

Companions on the Journey. St. Mary's Press.

This series invites one to pray along with and in the words of a saint.

When searching the Online Catalog, use subject terms like: Mysticism, Franciscans, Contemplation, Carmelite Spirituality, etc.

You might combine terms like **Jesuits**, or **Franciscans** with the term **Spiritual Life**, i.e. **Franciscans Spiritual Life**.

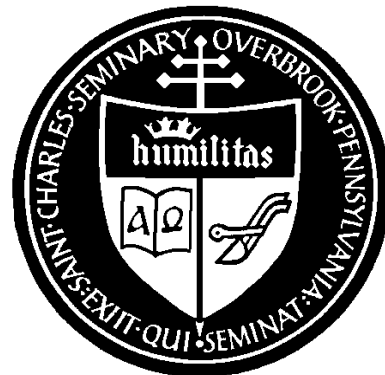
