Articles on particular topics (e.g. community, love, mortification) and on particular schools (e.g. Augustinian, Carmelite, Salesian). This work does not include biographical articles. Since this is a dictionary of contemporary Catholic spirituality, historical topics are treated only insofar as they relate to Catholic spirituality since Vatican II.

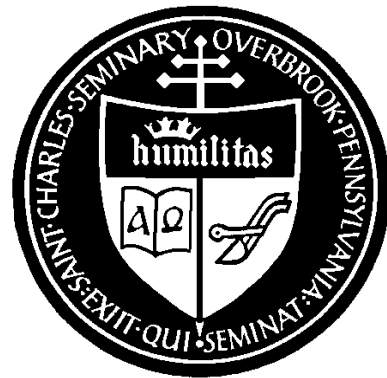
Classics of Western Spirituality. Paulist Press.

This series provides new translations and introductory material for a growing list of selected original works by masters of the western spiritual traditions. For a complete list of the Library's holdings, use the term "Classics of Western Spirituality" in the Online Catalog.

When Searching the Online Catalog, use subject terms like: Mysticism, Franciscans, Contemplation, Carmelite Spirituality, etc.

You might combine terms like **Jesuits**, or **Franciscans** with the term **Spiritual Life**, i.e. **Franciscans Spiritual Life**.
